

The Kabbalah Centre Charitable Causes provides humanitarian aid to people in need in partnership with other non-profit organizations. Through our partnership with Habitat for Humanity, we completed construction of five homes for families in need in Downey, California. In less than one year, we not only provided funds towards affordable housing and neighborhood revitalization, but our work with Habitat gave us a chance to work alongside these families in the building of each of these residences. The community named "Puebla de Luz," House of Light, is composed of two-story homes with sustainable energy features throughout its three-bedroom/two-bath units and houses families transitioning from difficult and substandard living conditions. We hope that the environment of strong, stable homes enables residents to become beacons of Light for each other, their neighbors and their community. Completing these homes created a tremendous opportunity to put into practice one of the most important spiritual principles we teach at The Kabbalah Centre --to give back to those in need.
